KS4 Science

KS4 AQA science students have been looking into chemical reactions. They carried out experiments to observe changes that take place when these reactions take place. One reaction they considered was between excess stomach acid (Hydrochloric acid) and an antacid (metal carbonate, Alka Seltzer for example). This type of reaction is called a Neutralisation reaction as it stabilizes the stomach pH.
