Sixth Form have started a mini— enterprise on Friday mornings. Students take orders, prepare and deliver a variety of coffees, hot chocolate and paninis currently to Key Stage 4 students and staff who are trialling it whilst they practice. Students have been trained to use the barista coffee machine and panini grill so they can experience practical work-based skills as preparation for adulthood and careers. Orders can be made and paid for in cash by Key Stage 4 students and staff during Friday registration time in the Sixth Form room. Hot drinks on offer are Mocha, Latte, Cappuccino and Hot Chocolate at £1.50 and Panini choices are Cheese, Cheese & Onion, Cheese & Ham and Cheese & Mediterranean Vegetables at £2. Vegan options are also available.











Restart a Heart

During the British Heart Foundation 'Restart a Heart' Day and as part of their Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Level Award, Key Stage 4 students have been learning CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation). Restart a Heart Day aims to raise awareness about cardiac arrest and helps people learn CPR, giving them life saving skills and the confidence to use them.

There are four main sections of a DofE programme; Volunteering, Physical, Skills and Expedition. Learning CPR has contributed towards the skills section for students.

Wolverhampton's Warm Spaces

The council will open its own wide range of buildings across the city and work with community and faith groups to offer not only a safe space for people to keep warm, but also to be able to charge and connect their devices and get a hot drink and something to eat. The spaces will be available from October 24 with a total of 30 venues initially opening their doors, including community centres, libraries and Strengthening Families hubs.
