

The 10 second rule.





The 10 second rule is where you ask a child a question, Pause and count to 10 in your head before asking another question or pushing for an answer if they don't respond.

This allows the child time to be able to listen, process and understand what has been said or asked of them without adding additional pressure.

WAIT 10 SECONDS

ASK AGAIN (IF NO ANSWER GIVEN)
