## Summer Fest 2024!

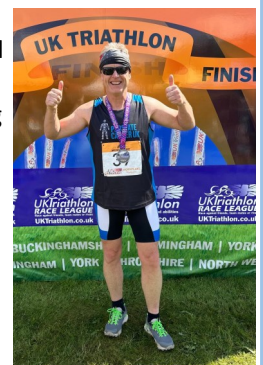
